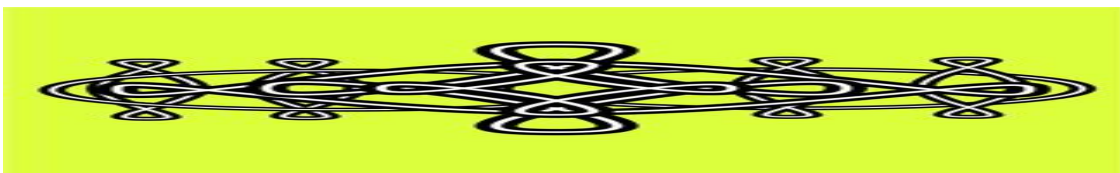

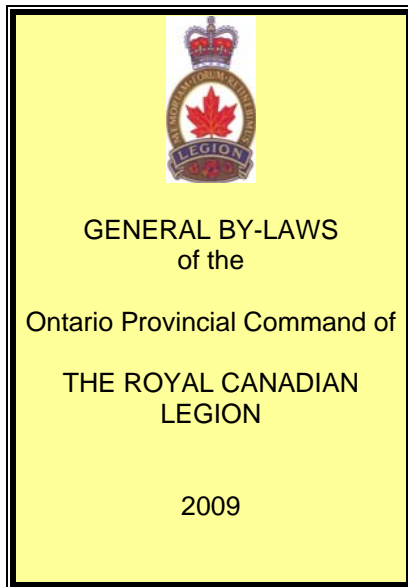

FYI. – Cde Charlie writes:

Not being familiar with the designation Camp - X/STS - 103 I took the liberty of looking it up on the internet. The following is a quote from what I found.

"December 6th 1941 William Stephenson of BSC in conjunction with Colin Gubbins Head of Special Operations Executive (SOE) established the first secret agent training facility in North America. The site, acquired by Stephenson's Canadian office, was located on 275 acres of isolated farm land bordering the north shore of Lake Ontario between the Town of Whitby and the City of Oshawa. The training facility, known under SOE designation as Special Training School STS-103 or "Camp X", shared space with a sophisticated top secret communications relay station (Hydra) which was established to facilitate the critical need for secure wartime transcontinental communications between Canada, Britain and the USA."

Please contact Mr. Friese if you have any information for him.
